STAFF RECOMMENDATION

That Council appoint Mr. Don Pearson as a Bylaw Enforcement Officer/Parking Officer in accordance with Section 36 of the Police Act, and that such appointment be for the term of his employment as Manager, Community Outreach with the City of Richmond.

STAFF REPORT

Don Pearson has assumed the position of Manager, Community Outreach on April 18, 2003.

It would be appropriate to provide the new Manager the ability to issue both Municipal Ticket Information and Parking Tickets.

Under the provisions of the Offence Act, for the purposes of the issuance of a violation ticket, and/or service of summons in respect of an alleged offence under a bylaw of a Municipality, a Peace Officer includes Bylaw Enforcement Officers as appointed under the Police Act.

In order to facilitate the issuance of these two types of tickets, as necessary, Council would need, under the Police Act, to:

- (i) appoint Mr. Don Pearson as a Peace Officer (as a Bylaw Enforcement Officer); and
- (ii) appoint him as Peace Officer (as a Parking Officer).

FINANCIAL IMPACT

CONCLUSION

It is recommended that Council authorise the appointment of Don Pearson as a Bylaw Enforcement Officer/Parking Officer in accordance with Section 36 of the Police Act, for the purposes of the service of a summons and the issuing of tickets under the authority of

Bylaw No. 7139.
